The time allocated for the public comment period will be limited to three minutes per person. The Planning Commission has the right to extend a speaker's time at their sole discretion. Both residents and non-residents shall provide their names and addresses to the Township Secretary to record in the minutes. Anyone who refuses to provide their name and address may not be recognized to speak. Anyone who conducts themselves in an inappropriate manner (as determined by the Chair) may be asked to leave the meeting. In the event that the Planning Commission determines that there is not sufficient time for residents or taxpayers of the Township to comment, the Board may defer the comment period to the next regular meeting.
